REGION

Grown on a mix of lime-rich and clay soils from the Blue Rock and Long Gully vineyards, Martinborough, New Zealand.

VARIETY

Pinot Gris 100%

VINIFICATION

Hand picked late harvested grapes were slowly and gently pressed to produce a fruit and floral, low alcohol, aperitif-like wine.

STYLE

Medium - sweet

A low alcohol wine with a touch of spritzig that enlivens ripe, sweet fruit characters of baked pear and stewed stone fruits. Vibrant acidity keeps this sweeter wine more aperitif-like than dessert-like in style.
