MURDOCH JAMES BLUE ROCK CABERNET FRANC 2012

REGION

Grown on the lime-rich soils of the Blue Rock vineyard, Dry River Terraces, Martinborough, New Zealand.

VARIETY

Cabernet Franc 100%

VINIFICATION

Hand-picked fruit from the lime-rich 'Nelson' block from 25 y.o. vines on own root stock. Fermented to 13.5% alc., and aged 10 months in seasoned French oak.

STYLE

Dry.

A classic Bordeaux blend which exhibits intense fruit flavours along with ripe, fresh, mouth-watering fruit acidity.

Rich, dark and brooding, with forest fruits, hot earth, cedar and a sprinkling of exotic tobacco. Silky, savoury and warm.
