



Te Mānia's vineyards, established in 1990, are located near the beautiful coastline of Tasman Bay on free draining, stony clay loam soils which have proved excellent for producing wine grapes of exceptional quality. Te Mania is a two-time winner of the prestigious Bragato Trophy for Best of Show.

Ice Riesling 2016

This delicious and seductive wine is made from Riesling grapes. It balances the sweet concentrated fruit flavours with firm acidity to create a special wine.

Fantastic on its own or you could match with fruits, nuts and cheeses. Skip desert and create a platter of your favourite after dinner nibbles to enjoy with friends.

Nose: Beautiful notes of citrus, honeysuckle, jasmine and apple blossom aromas.

Palate: Lovely balance of sweet citrus, luscious apple fruit and tangy lime acid. Fresh and intense, the wine is long and lingers with decadence.

Vintage: Grapes were harvested at the peak of ripeness. The juice was cool fermented to capture primary fruit characters. The wine was frozen then thawed to separate ice or water leaving the wine with concentrated fruit flavours and sweetness.

Analysis: Alcohol: 10.5% Residual Sugar: 105 gms/L Acidity: 8 gms/L



This is wonderfully lifted on the nose showing dried apricot, honey, marmalade and orange zest characters. The palate is beautifully sweet, but not overly sweet, with excellent fruit intensity and bright acidity, leading to a persistent refreshing finish.
