This shy bearing vine produces sophisticated and intriguing perfumed aromas - off peach and nectarine - with a rich yet subtle palate.

Aroma

Sweet peach and apricot, honey suckle and yellow flowers, with hints of vanilla and spice.

Palate

Dry with spicy notes. Fruity and layered with soft fragrances of flowers and then stone fruit flavours, with medium acidity.

Food Match

Roast chicken or quail, pork chops. Crayfish, crab or poached salmon.
