Paradise Pinot Noir 2011

Hidden in the folds of an historic gold mining valley at Bannockburn in Central Otago, the privately owned Domain Road Vineyard produces award-winning Pinot Noir, Sauvignon Blanc and Riesling wines.

A grape-loving micro-climate combined with a mix of soil types, including high quality loam and 'pipe clay' plus traditional hands-on viticulture yield wines of the finest quality.

The Wine

Our Paradise Pinot Noir is a reserve wine made to reflect the best of the vintage. Only 900 bottles are produced from barrel selections which are carefully aged before release.

The fruit was hand harvested on the 24th March 2011. After de stemming and a period of cold soak in Stainless tanks, the juice was fermented and transferred to French oak barriques for 10months. After choosing the wine to made into Paradise, it was transferred back to age in barriques for a further 4 months.

Our 2011 Paradise Pinot Noir is a vibrant deep purple in colour. On the nose it displays lifted perfumed notes of dark fruit, spice and violets. The palate has rich dark fruit with spicy, chary oak, leather and tobacco. A complex wine with fine grained silky tannins and a long lingering finish.
