MURDOCH JAMES ESTATE PINOT NOIR 2013

REGION

Grown on a mix of lime-rich and clay soils from the Blue Rock and Long Gully Vineyards, Martinborough, New Zealand.

VARIETY

Pinot Noir 100%

VINIFICATION

Hand-picked, de-stemmed and hand-sorted fruit, fermented in clonal parcels with separate yeast strains.

Transferred to a range of new and old French oak barrels for maturation before blending, filtering and egg white fining - 2 whites per barrel.

STYLE

Dry.

Blended from a selection of wine from mature oak barrels, this Pinot Noir displays soft and savoury complexities that are ready to enjoy right now.

CELLARING

Enjoy now and over the next 3-5 years.
