TASTING NOTE

VARIETAL: Cabernet Sauvignon

VINTAGE: 2019

REGION: McLaren Vale

PRODUCTION: 9000 bottles

VINEYARDS: Sourced from our organic Chalk Hill vineyard, with vines aged 25 years and 50 years of age.

OUR STORY: Chalk Hill was established in 1964 by the Harvey family. The first release of our Alpha Crucis wines was from the 2008 vintage. Alpha Crucis is the brightest star in the Southern Cross constellation, and these are the star wines of our vineyards.

THE WINE

AROMA: Dark berries, plum, spice, perfume, violets and dark chocolate.

TASTE: A rich and concentrated Cabernet, it is a complex wine with wonderful dark berry fruits combining with spice, dark chocolate and a hint of coffee. The finish is long and smooth.

CELLARING: Will reward cellaring for 5-7 years or more.

VINTAGE 2019

A warm, dry summer with lower than average yields. The smaller berries produced concentrated Cabernet Sauvignon wines with a rich textured mouthfeel and bold flavours.

WINEMAKING

The fruit was hand harvested and handled separately from each vineyard. After going through a 10 day fermentation on skins, it was transferred to a combination of new, 2nd and 3rd use French oak barrels, of which 15% were new. It spent 15 months in barrel prior to blending.

ALCOHOL: 14.5%
