



2019 Johanneshof Cellars Marlborough Riesling

Off-dry in style the Johanneshof Riesling 2019 has the bouquet of honeysuckle, white flowers and peaches.

This fullbodied, luscious wine shines with its intense flavours of peach, mango and rock melon supported by a good natural acidity which Warwick and Edel strive for in the vineyard. Hand harvested like all Johanneshof wines it is a powerful and yet elegant wine with a long, unctuous finish.

Johanneshof Cellars was established in 1991 and is jointly owned and operated by Edel Everling, a fifth generation winemaker from Germany and Warwick Foley from Marlborough. Both winemakers trained at Geisenheim University and worked in the world-famous wine area of Rheingau in Germany.

All Johanneshof grapes are hand-harvested from sustainable vineyards and fermented in small tanks or barrels with minimal intervention to ensure the highest quality. Johanneshof Cellars works sustainably in Vineyard and winery and is a registered and accredited New Zealand winery.

The quality of wines has been reflected in many awards and trophies, including the International Trophy for 'World Best Aromatic White Wine' in *Decanter World Wine Awards 2005* in London.
