AROMA: Perfumed nose with blueberry and red plum fruits with notes of florals, spice and chocolate notes.

THE WINE

TASTE: A medium to full bodied Shiraz, showing flavours of blueberries, red plums and cranberries with floral notes. It's textured with a fine lingering finish with spice and chocolate notes.

DRINKING WINDOW: Drinking well now or will cellar for 5-7 years.

FOOD MATCH: Rack of lamb with red wine jus.



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WINEMAKING

HARVEST: 7 different blocks were used for this wine. Each were harvested separately.

FERMENTATION: 7 day ferments, using cultured yeast. AGEING: Stored in a combination of older French oak barrels and stainless steel tank

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
