The Vineyard

Hey there! We're Chris and Jackie Paddon. Together with our family, we started Paddons Paddock vineyard in 2013, where we planted our Pinot Noir vines on our beautiful Wanaka vineyard. This region is well-known for Pinots, and we wanted to make the best Central Otago Pinot Noir we possibly could. A year later we planted our Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Gris and Chardonnay. Our vineyard is located 5 mins from Wanaka CBD.

Winemakers Notes

De-stemmed 100% with 6 hours skin contact 85% stainless steel fermentation and 15% older French barrique. Fermentation took 12 weeks and the wine rested on lees for 4 months before being racked and filtered for brightness and clarification.

Tasting Notes

Sauvignon Gris is its own clone, originating from Bordeaux and grows very well in colder climates. The wines produced from these grapes are richer/drier and more voluptuous in texture than sauvignon blancs. Paddons are one-of-only a handful of vineyards in New Zealand that grows this variety. Our Sauvignon Gris consists of ripe passionfruit, guava and spicy aromatics, on the palate the wine shows depth textural nuance with a lingering long lifted finish.
