



Bannockburn Pinot Noir 2021

A sheltered valley in one of New Zealand's best wine-growing regions is where Domain Road Vineyard calls home.

Domain Road Vineyard, owned and run by the Crosbie family, is a small producer of premium wines in Bannockburn, Central Otago, New Zealand. Two vineyards, one on Domain Road and the other on Felton Road are hand tended by a small team under the leadership of Steven Crosbie. Bannockburn's hot summers, followed by cool dry autumns allow the grapes to reach optimum maturity prior to harvest.

Gold miners have left their mark on the Central Otago landscape, altering the profiles of the surrounding hills and valleys in their search for the elusive metal. Our Pinot Noir vines grow on a rare Bannockburn site untouched by miners and delivers a complexity that truly reflects the unique location of the vineyard.

The Wine

The grapes from Defiance Vineyard (clones 113,115, 943 and Abel) were hand harvested on 27th & 28th March 2021. The fruit was destemmed into stainless steel tanks with approximately 8% added as whole bunch and inoculated with indigenous yeasts to carry out the fermentation. The wine was aged in French oak barriques (31% new) for approximately 10 months.

Deep garnet with purple hues in colour, our Pinot Noir has fragrant aromas of violets, dark cherry, blackberry, dark plum, spice, tobacco leaf and oak char with a touch of mint. The palate is rich and concentrated with ripe black plum, cherry, dark chocolate and blackberry. Full bodied with ample silky fine tannins leading to a long ripe berry finish.

Food match: New Zealand Lamb but try with Tuna or Salmon for a pleasant surprise. Vegetarian bakes – eggplant, lentils, mushrooms and tomato or creamy pumpkin risotto.
