

## RAMBLIN' ROSÉ 2020

In Margaret's bustling weekend restaurant Rosé occupies fully 50% of the wine on tables. So clearly a change in trend towards pink. There's little doubt that pale pink is an entrancing colour, especially when matched by the delicate flush of an animated imbibor as they engage in gossip. The subtle hue of Ramblin' Rosé is the result of a few hours contact with the skins of its Pinot Noir authors - Mariefield and a bit of 10/5. With 10gms of residual sugar Ramblin' Rosé is off dry and so equally suited to sipping or partnering our edgy tapas menu. It has a vibrant sweetness on entry relieved by zingy acid at the tail end. On nose and palate, our panel suggested strawberry, bolstered by: fruit salad, guava, tropical fruits and rhubarb. Sounds plausible. Although not designed for ageing a nice ripe vintage like 2020 will be equally delicious in 2-3 years.
