



Te Mānia's vineyards, established in 1990, are located near the beautiful coastline of Tasman Bay on free draining, stony clay loam soils which have proved excellent for producing wine grapes of exceptional quality. Te Mānia is a two-time winner of the prestigious Bragato Trophy for Best of Show.

Nelson Sauvignon Blanc 2020

Sauvignon Blanc is ideally suited to the Nelson region where a combination of warm, sunny days and cool autumn nights, help to create the intense varietal flavours for which this flagship New Zealand wine is recognized.

Nose: Intense floral, gooseberry, elderflower notes with fresh herbs (mint/basil).

Palate: Rich fleshy palate with ripe passionfruit, guava, feijoa fruit with complex herb flavor and a crisp fresh finish. A vibrant, full flavored wine that is concentrated and long.

Vintage: A dry warm spring resulted in good flowering and fruit set. A long sunny summer resulted in excellent flavour development. All fruit was crushed and destemmed before being cool fermented to preserve the vibrant, fresh Sauvignon characters.

Organic Status: Certified Organic Assure Quality New Zealand.

Diet: Suitable for a vegan diet.

Analysis: Alcohol 13.5% Residual Sugar 3.7 gms/L Acidity 7.7 gms/L
