

Te Mānia's vineyards, established in 1990, are located near the beautiful coastline of Tasman Bay on free draining, stony clay loam soils which have proved excellent for producing wine grapes of exceptional quality. Te Mania is a two-time winner of the prestigious Bragato Trophy for Best of Show.

Nelson Sauvignon Blanc 2022

Sauvignon Blanc is ideally suited to the Nelson region where a combination of warm, sunny days and cool autumn nights, help to create the intense varietal flavours for which this flagship New Zealand wine is recognized.

Nose: Green rockmelon, apricot, lemon peel and sweet basil.

Palate: Rich fleshy palate with ripe passionfruit, guava, lemon and green apple with complex herb flavor and a crisp fresh finish. A vibrant, full flavored wine that is concentrated and long.

Vintage: A very good year for Sauvignon Blanc with nice rich flavorsome crop. A sunny beginning of the summer resulted in excellent flavour development and almost like a second spring February provided very fresh and fruity notes. All fruit was crushed and destemmed before being cool fermented to preserve the vibrant, fresh Sauvignon characters.

Organic Status: Certified Organic Bio Gro New Zealand.

Diet: Suitable for a vegan diet.

Analysis: Alcohol 13.0% Residual Sugar 4.0 gms/L Acidity 7.6 gms/L
