THE VINEYARD

The 2019 Old Coach Road Nelson Rosé comes from our Brightwater vineyard blocks. The Brightwater Vineyard vines are grown in an extremely stony area of the vineyard where water and nutrient levels are low. This helps us to restrict the plants vigour and to crop at low levels. To further enhance the aromatics, leaves were removed to allow light penetration and air movement around the fruiting zone.

WINEMAKERS NOTE

2019 is our second vintage of Rosé for our Old Coach Road range. Rosé is such a refreshing and crisp wine, perfect to sip and enjoy on those beautiful sunny afernoons. Enjoy!

TASTING NOTE

The 2019 Old Coach Road Nelson Rosé has a gorgeous dusty pink hue. The wine is crisp, flavoursome and refreshing with appealing notes of Guava, watermelon and iced tea. The finish is warm dry and refreshing.
